- 3) Lawn chairs and standing spectators must remain on the grass or sidewalk on the back side of the building.
- 4) Siblings/family members are not allowed to wait on campus until game start due to no supervision.
- 5) Games start promptly at 4:30 pm.
- 6) Once the game ends, coaches will announce the winning team.
- 7) Please only park in the side parking spaces (Westside Drive) or the front of the school.
- 8) If you do not attend the game, you can pick your child up at the front of the building.
