CELL PHONE POLICY OF AAJP

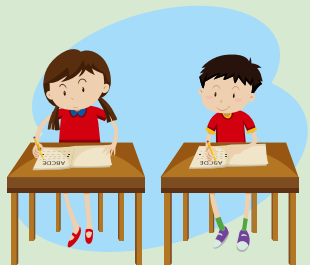
As we get closer to taking the LEAP test we wanted to reiterate the cell phone policy of AAJP. Student Policy #5402 which can be found in the Family Handbook and online at <https://www.athlosjp.org/wp-content/uploads/bsk-pdf-manager/2019/05/5402-Electronic-Devices-Policy.pdf> states the following:

Students may possess electronic devices at school subject to the following conditions: 1. Students may carry and possess electronic devices to and from school. 2. Personal electronic devices must be turned off and kept in backpacks during school hours except if otherwise allowed by a school teacher or administrator for educational purposes. 3. Students shall be personally and solely responsible for the security of personal electronic devices brought to school. 4. Athlos Academy of Jefferson Parish shall not assume responsibility for theft, loss, damage, or unauthorized calls made with a student's personal electronic device. 5. Students may use their personal electric device if the use is established by the appropriate administrator to be necessary for other special circumstances, health-related reasons, or emergency.

Please discuss this and other points in the policy with your student (s), and ensure that they are following the policy at all times. This also includes headphones, Apple Watches, Air Pods, and other Bluetooth devices. If you have any questions, please reach out to the appropriate administrator.
