KEEP THEM CLEAN

Since we are currently in flu season and with all of the other health issues that have been in the news lately; it has been suggested that prevention methods are discussed with all staff and students at Athlos Academy of Jefferson Parish.

Here are some basic methods from the CDC :

Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

Stay home when you are sick, symptoms such as high fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, please keep them home until they are symptom free for 24 hours.

Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue and discard in the trash.

Wash hands often for 20 seconds or more especially, after the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing nose or coughing.

Use hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol base.
