

If your student tests positive COVID then they must quarantine for 5 days from their positive test with day 1 being the day after they were tested.

For example: If your student tests positive COVID from a test done on Sunday, then the student's day 1 of quarantine would be Monday and the student's last day of quarantine would be Friday. The student would be able to return to school that following Monday. Symptoms continue after 5 days of quarantine, then must continue to quarantine until symptoms are resolving and are without fever for 24 hours without the help of Tylenol or Motrin.
