| Review Technology Purchase Bids (5 minutes) | Recommend bid to accept for technology purchases | Jeff Gunther Two bids were received for technology needs: H Wire and Stability Network. Stability was cheaper on the laptop carts. H Wire was cheaper on the computers. Ben Bourgeois makes a motion to accept H Wire's bid for computers, and if agreed by Stability to supply carts only, Athlos accepts bid on the carts. John Foard seconds the motion.
